

With the spread of SARS-CoV-2 (coronavirus), many customers understandably have questions regarding the correct procedures to keep their mats clean and their team/athletes and themselves safe. The following guidelines have been developed to help customers properly disinfect/sanitize their mats.

## Vinyl Mats (Wrestling, Martial Arts)

Vinyl mats should be disinfected before or after each use. There are a variety of mat cleaners on the market that are recognized by the EPA for use against SARS-CoV-2, including Husky 800 and mPerial cleaners, which are available for purchase in our online store. We also recommend ProKure™ V Liquid Disinfectant/Virucide/Deodorizer as an alternative.

### Instructions:

- 1) Pre-clean heavily soiled areas.
- 2) Dilute solution, using manufacturer's guidelines.
- 3) Apply with mop, handheld sprayer, or electrostatic sprayer.
- 4) Surface must stay wet for specified amount of time (refer to product label)
- 5) Rinse with clean water or allow to air dry.

## Carpet Bonded Foam Mats (Cheerleading, Gymnastics)

While most porous surfaces, like carpet, cannot be completely disinfected, the risk of spreading pathogens/microbials can be mitigated by following a regular cleaning/sanitizing schedule. We recommend vacuuming before or after each use, and deep cleaning on a regular basis with a sanitizing solution like Sporidicin® or MediClean® (formerly MicroBan®).

### Instructions:

- 1) Clear the mat of all obstructions and debris.
- 2) Vacuum the entire surface of the mat.
- 3) Use a hot water extraction cleaner or "steam" cleaner with a sanitizing solution, or apply with a handheld or electrostatic sprayer and allow carpet to remain damp for recommended time.
- 4) Allow mat to dry fully before using or rolling up for storage.
